We are looking forward to seeing you again at Holy Trinity. To help the children settle in to their new school, we have a transition plan, aimed to help the children feel comfortable and confident in September. This includes our Open Evening, 'buddy days' and various other special events to help the children to become familiar with Holy Trinity.

This half term our staff will visit the Year 2 children in their own classes at Beddington Infants in order to start to get to know them. The Year 2 children's 'buddy days' will be held on the mornings of 28<sup>th</sup> June and 3<sup>rd</sup> July from 9.30 – 11.30am. For 'shuffle up', when the children will be in their new classroom with their new teacher, on the morning of 9<sup>th</sup> July from 11.30-12.15pm, children from Beddington Infants School will be brought across the playing field. The children will not need to be accompanied by their parents. However, the children who do not attend Beddington Infants School should be brought to Holy Trinity at the times specified above so that they can spend time in their new classes. Some of our Year 5 children will also go to meet the children to talk about peer mediators (helpers in the playground) and they will show the Year 2 children how to use our play equipment and the routines for play and lunch time. Year 2 children are also invited to join us for the dress rehearsal of the Year 6 production on Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> July at 1.45pm.

You and your child in Year 2 are invited to attend our Open Evening which will be held at 6.00pm on Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> July. At 6pm, the children will come to the school hall and will then go to their new classroom with their teacher. In the hall I will be talking to parents. This time the talk has the purpose of giving key information which you will need for the first few weeks. Mrs Robins, the deputy head, will also be here for you to meet as will our Senco, Mrs Cooper.

*You may wish to bring some cash for the evening. There will be good quality second hand uniform on sale and red book bags. Items of uniform cost 50p or £1 and book bags cost £2.30.*

There will also be forms to complete for our Breakfast Club, should you wish to apply for it. We will also have information about our after school provision called Fit For Sport. The letter about it is on our website.

From 6.30pm it is open evening in the rest of the school, so when your children have been collected from their new class, you may look around the whole school and see the wonderful display of work by our children.

**I do hope you and your child will be able to attend, as it really is an important part of the transition.**

We look forward to meeting you on the evening of 9<sup>th</sup> July.
