PUPIL PREMIUM- IS YOUR CHILD ENTITLED?

What is the Pupil Premium?

The Government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income families do their very best. This money is called a 'Pupil Premium'. Historically, it seems that many children who come from families with a lower income go on to achieve less well. Naturally, we want all children to achieve well and strive for this at Holy Trinity.

Money? From the Government! For my child? Surely not!



What benefits can be gained from the Pupil Premium for my child at Holy Trinity?

If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium he/she will be entitled to

- Targeted support to aid progress and attainment
- Homework club
- Priority to ELSA (should it be required, depending on availability)
- **Free school dinner** if your child would like one which could save up to £427.50 per year. (Children in KS2 are no longer entitled to free school meal as they are in KS1)

Applying for a free school meal and for the Pupil Premium is now easy and more confidential. If you are in receipt of one of the following you are eligible to apply.

- 1) Income Support.
- 2) Income based Job Seeker's Allowance.
- 3) Income related Employment and Support Allowance.
- 4) Child Tax Credit - Where the family's annual income is not more than £16,190 and Working Tax Credit is not in payment.
- 5) Guarantee Pension Credit.
- 6) Support under part six of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- 7) Universal Credit.

Also qualifying for Pupil Premium are:

- Children who have ceased to be looked after by a local authority in England and Wales because of adoption, a special guardianship order, a child arrangements order or a residence order
- Pupils in year groups reception to year 11 recorded as Ever 5 Service Child or in receipt of a child pension from the Ministry of Defence
