DID YOU KNOW? World War 2 was a battle between two groups of countries - the Allied powers and the Axis Powers. The major Allied Powers were Britain, France, Russia, China and the United States. The major Axis Powers were Germany, Italy and Japan.

- Together with the Nazi Party, Hitler wanted Germany to rule Europe. To gain more land and power, on 1 September 1939 German troops invaded Poland. After Hitler refused to stop the invasion, Britain and France declared war on Germany- World War II had begun.
- The bombing of London, known as The Blitz, lasted for 57 consecutive nights. Hitler wanted to quash the British spirit so they would surrender.
- The Battle of Britain was the first military campaign fought solely in the air.

• Both the allies and the axis powers used propaganda posters to boost the morale of people at home and those fighting. It was also used to decrease the morale of the enemy. The US didn't join the war until 1941, when Japan attacked the United States
