<p>Google Meets: We have been pleased to see most of you joining in with the google meets and ensuring that you are on time. You have managed so well with finding your way around the folders and turning work in.</p>	<p>Google Meets: We would like you to continue to arrive to the meets online and ready to learn. Please remember a piece of paper and pencil to make notes that will help you with your learning.</p>
<p>Writing: We have been very impressed with the quality of the writing and most of you are remembering to use the 'Year 4 Writing Checklist' when we provide it on the slides. We are also pleased that most of you are uploading photos of your hand written pieces of writing.</p>	<p>Writing: Please continue to upload photos of your written work so that we can see you are still practising your handwriting. Always remember to proof read your writing whether it is typed or written.</p>
<p>Maths: The majority of you are showing that you are understanding your work. The responses to challenge questions is improving and most of you are using examples to show your understanding.</p>	<p>Maths: Continue to watch the maths videos especially if you are struggling with the work. If you are able, you should be attempting the challenge questions.</p>
<p>WCR: We can tell that you are really enjoying our WCR book The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe and attempting the reading activities.</p>	<p>WCR: When answering try to remember to use evidence from the text and continue to use your scanning skills to retrieve answers.</p>
<p>Foundation: It has been great to see most of you getting involved in the Science investigations! We have also really enjoyed reading your responses to RHE and History and seeing your artwork.</p>	<p>Foundation: Remember to keep active! PE is an important part of the curriculum so complete the daily tasks or go out for a walk, cycle or run.</p>
