Re: Year 5 and 6 school clubs for SUMMER 2024 – clubs are from 3.10-4.10pm and Football clubs are 3.15-4.15pm

We are writing to let you know about the clubs that will be running after school in the Summer term.

Clubs will begin in the week of the 22nd of April.

Within our vision, as you know, we would like as many children as possible to have the opportunity to have a club in the academic year.

In school today, we asked the children which of them has not had any club at all this academic year, in the autumn or spring. For those absent from school today, we will do our best to check their situation through our records.

We would like to offer clubs, first, to those who have not yet had any. If they do not wish to take any places, then the clubs will be opened up to all of the other children in the school equally.

Children who qualify for free school meals have also been offered one free club this year. This means they can have one free club for a term in any one academic year. Please could any parents of children who qualify for free school meals and who did not have a free club in the Autumn or Spring terms make their child's preferred club known to the School office staff by 15.4.24 so that they can be allocated the club of their choice.

Please note: All children must be collected from school after a club has finished, unless in year 6 and already have permission to walk home alone. See timings above.
