We use these assessments alongside class work to see where the children are in terms of their learning.






Whole Class Reading:

Accelerated Reading

<u>At</u> Holy Trinity we use an online platform called accelerated reader or renaissance reading to better help us address the individual reading needs of each child.


- the programme helps us to assess each child's reading ability, provides guidance for their choice of books and allows us to track how well they are understanding.

- every half term, each child will complete an online reading assessment (called Star Reader).

- each child will then be given a range - for example 3.3-4.5. We have made this simpler for the children by giving them two colours e.g. a purple blue.

Children will choose a book that falls within their range. They will then need to complete an online quiz about the book.

These quizzes will support teachers in assessing how well your child is **understanding** what they are reading and allow us to put **interventions** in where needed.

Chrome Books


- Will have access to a Chromebook at least 1 day a week and when they need to quiz a book






The children will have learnt the 2, 5 and 10 times tables in KS1. In year 3, they will learn the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.
