Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Clubs update.

We have had a look at our school clubs provision for next term. Having consulted the children, as well as speaking with coaches and providers for their feedback we will be offering the following clubs after school. To provide clarity for each club a small summary has been provided so that when signing up the children understand what will be involved.

As you can see, Art club will no longer be running as we do not have anyone currently who can run this club after school. We have however, tried to create opportunities to introduce new sports and give girls in lower Key Stage 2 the chance to take part in football club.

Day	Club	Run by
Monday	Year 6 Netball - capacity 18	<b>School - Playground</b> This is run by Mrs Jules and Miss Alexander who as priority will be inviting those who trained with them in Autumn. If there is space, we will then open this up to the rest of the Year group.
	Year 3 and 4 Boys' Football – capacity 16	<b>Vision Coaching - Field</b> This will be a mix of skills and game time, working on sportspersonship, team work and skill improving.
	Year 3 & 4 Gymnastics (max. 20)	<b>Mrs Morley – Hall</b> Working on a variety of gymnastic skills.
Tuesday	Y3-6 Karate	<b>BASK - Hall</b> This will be a mix of stamina building exercises and the skill of karate.
	Year 4, 5 & 6 Athletics - capacity 16	<b>School - Field</b> Mr Mensah will run this either on the field or playground and will work on different skills in athletics in both track and field events.
	Year 3 & 4 Girls' Football - capacity 16	<b>Vision Coaching – Field</b> This will be a mix of skills and game time, working on sportsmanship, team work and skill improving.
Wednesday	Year 5 & 6 Multisport (Spring term) - capacity 16	<b>School – Field</b> Mr Mensah will be working on a two week cycle for each sport giving children opportunity to develop their skills in a range of sports including tag rugby, hockey, American football, dodge-ball and badminton. These will all involve a mix of skills and small team games.  <i>In the Summer term Y3 and 4 will be given the opportunity to take part in this club.</i>



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	Year 6 Boys' Football (CLUB) - capacity 16 This will be released once trials and the team have been chosen – please look out for a separate letter.	<b>Community Advantages - Field</b> Trials will take place on Wednesday 8 <sup>th</sup> and Thursday 9 <sup>th</sup> January for Year 5 and 6 respectively. There will be a letter to follow.
<b>Thursday</b>	Year 6 Boys' Football (TEAM) - capacity 16 This will be released once trials and the team have been chosen – please look out for a separate letter.	<b>Community Advantages – Field</b> Trials will take place on Wednesday 8 <sup>th</sup> and Thursday 9 <sup>th</sup> January for Year 5 and 6 respectively. There will be a letter to follow.
	Year 3 – 6 Street Dance - capacity 25	<b>DanceMode Academy – Hall</b> Children will work as a team as well as working in small groups to do some creative work and will be working towards an end of term performance to parents. Street dance club will be vibrant and energetic, allowing children to express themselves freely!
	Year 3 – 6 Handball	<b>School – Playground</b> This is a new sport that we will be introducing in Holy Trinity. The children will be working on team-work, coordination, attacking and defence skills.
<b>Friday</b>	Y5 & 6 Girls' Football	<b>School – Field</b> This will be a mix of skills and game time, working on sportspersonship, team work and skill improving run by Mr Mensah.
	Year 5 & 6 Gymnastics (max. 20)	<b>Mrs Morley – Hall</b> Working on a variety of gymnastics skills such as rolls, jumps and balance.

\* Children who are eligible for Free School Meals will be entitled to one term of a free club per school year.

Clubs will begin from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2025 and run till Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025. Clubs will be available on a first come, first served basis and will become available to book on **ParentPay** from **8pm Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December**.
