Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope this letter finds you well and that you had a restful and enjoyable Summer.

We are writing to ask for your support with a voluntary contribution to the school's maintenance fund. **This fund helps us carry out essential building work and improvements to ensure our children have a safe, high-quality learning environment.**

What we're asking for:

A contribution of **£40 per family**, to be paid via **ParentPay** by **31st October 2025**. Payments can be made in instalments or in full. The minimum contribution is **£10**.

Why we need your support:

Each year, the government allocates around **£8,554** towards maintaining and improving our school building. This amount does not cover all necessary costs. In order to access larger funding through the Southwark Diocese (which supports Church of England schools), we must also contribute approximately **£9,500** from our own funds.

Last year, this partnership helped us to:

- Install a **new boiler** – 90% of the cost was covered by the Diocese, while the remaining 10% (**£24,100**) came from the school's maintenance fund.
- Replaced corridor flooring at a cost of **£14,384**
- Paint the corridors at a cost of **£5,985**.

This year, our priorities include:

- **Carry out damp proofing and tanking in two classrooms** – 90% of the cost will be covered by the Diocese, while the remaining 10% (**approx. £10,597**) will need to come from the school's maintenance fund.
- **Upgrading the electrics** – we hope the Diocese will help fund this
- **Improving playground equipment** – PFOS are also working to raise funds.
- **Replacing desks in 5 classrooms**

We understand times are difficult, and we appreciate any amount you are able to give. If you have any questions about how the maintenance funding works, please don't hesitate to ask – we'd be happy to explain.
