The cost of the 4-night stay is **£623**.

This is £587 (early bird discount) for PGL, plus £36 coach travel.

This is comparative to other places we have looked at and researched. We have also spoken to other schools who are at a similar price point to us.

First non-refundable deposit - £65 to be paid by Thursday 19th March 2026.

Second non-refundable deposit - £125 to be paid by Thursday 18th June 2026.

Total cost: Paid by Friday 19th March 2027

After the two deposits have been made, the monthly breakdown between July-March would be £48.10 – final payment to be made by Friday 19th March 2027

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
Instagram

Behaviour

We expect the highest standards of behaviour from the children.

Rudeness, disobedience or dangerous/anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated.

Sanctions

Loss of some/all of free time.

Withdrawal from activities.

Contact parents.

Removal from the trip. In this event, parents will be expected to collect their child from the site.

Children will be organised in activity groups of around 10-12.

Rooms are usually in groups of 4-6 but we don't find this out until a couple of months before.

Rooms are not mixed gender.

Children will be asked to choose two friends – this is not dependent on which class they in.

We will endeavour to guarantee one of these friends in their room and/or activity.

If they don't get a room with both of their friends, we will try our hardest to ensure they are all in a group together.

Children will find out their groups/rooms the week after SATs, which is the last week of the half term.
