Year 3 and 4 school clubs for Summer term

Clubs will begin from Monday 20th April 2026 and run weekly until Friday 10th July 2026 (unless otherwise stated). Details of the options for Years 3 and 4 are overleaf. Clubs will be available on a first come, first served basis and will be available to book on Arbor or direct with the provider from **8pm Monday 16th March 2026 until 9am Monday 13th April 2026**. If there are no sessions showing as available to book this means the club is full. For guidance on how to book via Arbor please see the school website

Once booked and paid for on Arbor the place is secure and it will show in your account, you will not get a confirmation email from the school. If you do not make a payment your place is not confirmed.

If booking is via the provider, please use the link shown overleaf and follow the instructions on their website. These will also be available to book from 8pm Monday 16th March.

Children who are eligible for Free School Meals are entitled to one term of a free club per school year. If your child has not already had a free place this school year, please let the office staff know your child's preference by 3pm 17th March 2026 and they will book this for you. This applies to clubs booked via Arbor and direct with the provider.

If there are any clubs with spaces, we will let everyone know by Wednesday 18th March 2026. Club providers reserve the right to cancel a club if there is not enough interest to make it viable.

All sessions must be booked and paid for in advance before any child begins a club. If your child attends a club without the place being prebooked and paid for they will be turned away and you will be asked to collect them.

Some club prices may seem more expensive this term but this is due to the length of the term – the weekly prices have remained the same.

Pupils should wear their PE kits to school on any day they attend a sports club.

Please note: All children must be collected from school after a club has finished promptly at 4.10pm unless they are prebooked on to PASS.
