May 2026

In Summer 2, the whole school will be moving onto the Relationship and Health Education unit called "Changing me", which children will cover every year at this time. This topic covers how we might change over time and each year group covers various age-related topics.

This unit looks at how the body develops, preparing the children for changes as they grow, drawing on the knowledge of the human life cycle. This knowledge is also tied into our Relationships and Health Education curriculum which also requires us to discuss key facts of puberty (including the changing adolescent body, menstruation) and conception, which are covered across the year groups.

This learning involves developing an understanding of changes for both male and females - reassurance and exploring feelings and how to look after yourself. This does involve the use of scientific diagrams of male and female reproductive organs.

All of the content will be scientific and in lessons, any discussion will remain strictly within the limits of the curriculum content stated above. Any questions children have that are not related to those objectives will be referred back to parents in a sensitive way.

We would like to invite all parents/carers in for a consultation on Monday, 1st June in the hall from 3.20 – 3.45pm to talk about the RHE "Changing me" learning journey across the school. There will be a 'creche' with a class teacher available on the day to watch over children, if needed, while parents/carers attend the talk. We hope that this will inform and support you to continue these important topics at home.
